2020 – 2021 FINANCIL AID AND TUITION GUIDELINES

Tulsa Hope Academy recognizes a private Christian education is a financial investment in your child's future. While we believe it is the primary responsibility of the student's family to bear the cost of attendance, we are committed to partnering with families who demonstrate a financial need. Through our generous donors, GEER Scholarships, and the Opportunity Scholarship Fund we are able to provide financial assistance to many families. In return, students are asked to participate in a work-study donor appreciation program.

In order to keep the costs of our program to a minimum, we ask that families sign up for autopay using a debit or credit card or a pre-paid card.


